With high yield potential, excellent winterhardiness, and good plant height, Blaze is uniquely adapted to the northern and north/central portions of Washington.

Blaze stands well at harvest and can be cut with flex or rigid headers.

Blaze is ideally suited for the wheat-fallow regions of Washington and provides growers in with a viable alternative to winter wheat.

Yield: Yield of Blaze has shown itself to be equal to Windham, producing yields well over 4,000 lbs/acre.

Winter Durability: Blaze provides 'best-in-class' winter hardiness, surviving temperatures as low as -5° F.

Seed Type and Market: Blaze is a yellow pea with improved seed size for adaptability to split yellow market, pet food market and human ingredient market. Not adaptable for whole yellow market.
